- Canned fruit (peaches, pears, fruit cocktail)
- Pastas / Sauces
- Rice
- Dry Beans
- Soy or Rice drink products

PERISHABLES

- Milk
- Juice
- Eggs
- Yogurt
- Cottage Cheese
- Sour Cream
- Soy products (soy milk, tofu, garden burgers, etc.)
- Produce – Carrots, squash, tomatoes, etc
- Meat—Hamburger, chicken, etc

FROZEN:

Turkeys, whole fryer chickens, hamburger, ham, frozen juice concentrates, etc.
